With this “innovative” project with her leadership and that of QC City Administrator Michael Victor Alimurung, “2,699 homes will be immediately made available to beneficiaries from District 2.” She also praised 8990 for building a beautiful development for low-income earners since “they deserve the best.”

For his part, Martinez declared that this milestone is 8990’s first housing project wherein they have partnered with a local government unit (LGU). He expressed hope that with these new, ready homes, the community will be “closer to an inclusive and empowered Quezon City.”
